I'm sure there will be plenty of the situation is this: This proves that the most important element in getting recognition as a writer is a great story - plain and simple. But the point is, it's impossible to forget this guy - and a great reminder of how important it is to write at least one great character into your movie. I literally think it's impossible to make a movie where a person is tortured and killed by the bad guy, and not want the protagonist to enact revenge on that bad guy. The Sheriff (whose wife was raped and murdered) travels to the town where the leader of this brigand lives in order to settle the score. How bout 138 pages? I'm going to go on record as saying that, in my opinion, this would be the greatest Western ever made. How bout a Western? Actors will be kicking themselves to play this role. It's a huge risk for the writer to take because as we find out later, the storm that is summoned is the driving force behind the entire story. Like his other work, he balances a wide-range of emotions with memorable characters, very creative plotting, and remains unafraid to push the audience into unbearably intense scenes of horror. I came to it late, but ROOM was really, really amazing as well. Is this a fantasy film? The Brigand of Rattleborge starts interestingly enough. What was the strangest job you ever had before becoming a writer?Prior to writing full-time, I worked as an assistant to a producer and then to a lit manager. These were not so much strange, as much as just a daily motivator to write every day, though they did allow me access to as many scripts as I could get my hands on while also forcing me to write coverage — which I think is critical for an aspiring writer, as this really demands for one to think analytically and articulate their thoughts about the writing in terms of craft. The Present: How do you find ideas and how do you choose which ones to work on? My process usually begins with wanting to tackle a genre at large or explore a character within a genre. Most of it was way, way the hell too long and not that enlightening — basically more of an excuse for me to rant about whatever I was watching/reading at the moment — but it was important for helping to develop my own voice and think critically about why I kept responding to certain aspects of storytelling more than others, so probably pursuing some kind of job along those lines. Dinner with three of your favorite writers and/or filmmakers, dead or alive. And yet somehow, someway...you believe that it's possible. Then, during the first draft, I usually write between five-eight pages a day — basically one scene or two — and try to finish this before lunch. The worst thing that you can do is have finished material sitting in a drawer - giving it the smallest percentage of finding success via The Black List site tops the zero percent that it will find collecting dust. Those movies were definitely my gateway drug into film at large as a kid, and there is a wall-sized poster of Kong beside my bed that I still wake up to every morning. That playlist will really end up becoming the emotional DNA of the screenplay-trying to translate how a song makes me feel into modulating the momentum and emotional intention of each scene.
